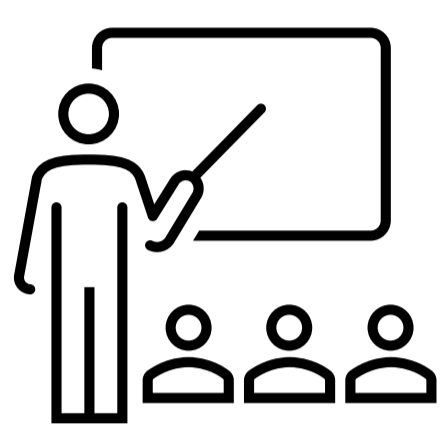

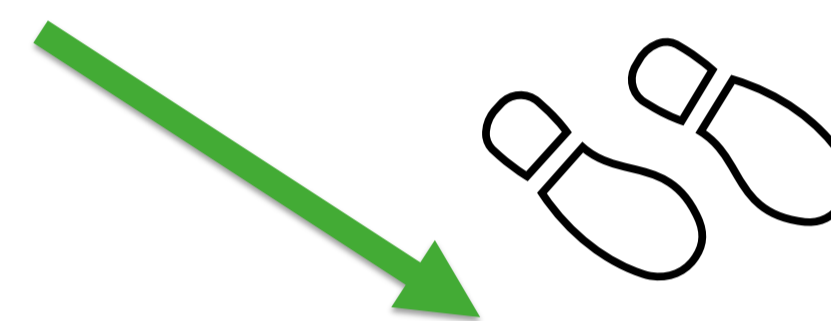

A congress for the Future - independently organized by children for younger children

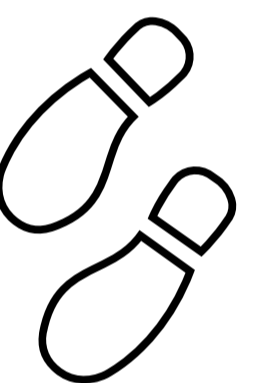


- + School lessons: „Future and climate change“

- + Participation in the „Virtual Future Congress“ of the Hessian Ministry of Education

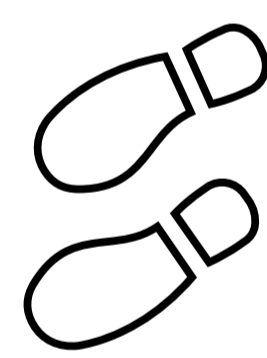


*„We will organize our own congress.

10 workshops (self developed by the 16)
in **3 rounds of workshops**,
for over **90 primary school pupils**
and guided the workshops **ALONE** in
teams of two.

congress



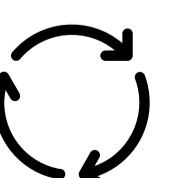
